Message From Fr. Kramer Cameron, LC

Dear Families and Friends of Santi Apostoli,

Today we are celebrating the 6th Sunday of Easter. Next Sunday is already the Ascension. In the Office of Readings yesterday, we read from St. Augustine's discourse on the psalms: "The Lord's passion depicts for us our present life of trial – shows how we must suffer and be afflicted and finally die. The Lord's resurrection and glorification show us the life that will be given to us in the future."

How much preparation do we put into getting ready for Easter? We have a long period called Lent where we often make a mini fasting program, abstain from meat on Fridays, pray more, do charity, etc. This is important and good. It unites us to Jesus' passin and death.

What do we do for Easter? How do you celebrate Jesus' resurrection? Do you have a mini Easter program? This is the most important time of the year: celebrating the resurrected Jesus! I recommend that we as a community each find ways to make this last week before the Ascension an experience of joy and the resurrection.
