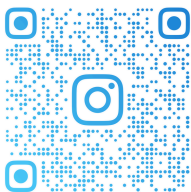

Message From Fr. Kramer Cameron, LC

Dear Families and Friends of Santi Apostoli,

Today is Palm Sunday! Just as Jesus stood outside the gates of Jerusalem and the doors were opened for him, so today many people are standing and knocking on the doors of our fortified hearts. What if Jesus is constantly coming to the gates of our hearts like he did 2000 years ago? Do we let him in? What if he comes and knocks as those in need? Do we let him in? Do we open our hearts to those in need? Please, I beg you, Jesus begs you, don't come waving palm branches or olive branches singing "Jesus! We love you! Come into our Church, our hearts!" and then step through the doors of the Church and into the world and not help your brothers and sisters in need. Jesus speaks to our hearts today: "Truly, I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of these my brothers and sisters, you did it to me."

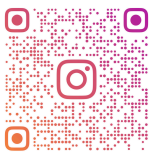
Let's also continue to mediate on Pope Francis' Lenten Message which is very much related to our reflection today:

"Second, to journey together. The Church is called to walk together, to be synodal Christians are called to walk at the side of others, and never as lone travellers. The Holy Spirit impels us not to remain self-absorbed, but to leave ourselves behind and keep walking towards God and our brothers and sisters. Journeying together means consolidating the unity grounded in our common dignity as children of God (cf. Gal 3:26-28). It means walking side-by-side, without shoving or stepping on others, without envy or hypocrisy, without letting anyone be left behind or excluded. Let us all walk in the same direction, tending towards the same goal, attentive to one another in love and patience.."

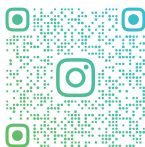

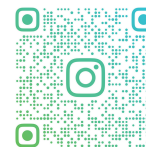
